

# President and CEO Monthly Report to CHC Board of Directors February 21, 2022

Reporting period: January 25, 2022 – February 21, 2022

# Funding:

- Federal fiscal year ended in October funding maintained through Continuing Resolutions (CR)
- Current CR expires on March 11<sup>th</sup>
- Parallel negotiations regarding another Continuing Resolution or rolling all
   12 appropriations bills into an Omnibus package
- September 30<sup>th</sup> hard deadline for passage of Build Back Better (in some form) – likely to be "transformed"

## COVID 19 Response:

 Public Health Emergency (PHE) set to expire on March 31<sup>st</sup> resulting in the unwinding of any remaining associated benefits (i.e. telehealth flexibility)

## 340B Drug Pricing Program:

- PROTECT 340B Bill prohibiting discriminatory contracting based on 340B eligibility is slowly gaining support positive response from SC Congressional delegation during P&I Hill visits
- Recent court ruling on legality of contract pharmacy model are discouraging

# State activity:

- SCPHCA Legislative Committee meets monthly on the first Friday of each month.
- Request for \$8 million in annualized funding for health centers remains intact in the budget deliberations
- Hot topic: Eliminating Certificate of Need requirement for health care facilities and equipment
  - Applies to health centers <u>only</u> for equipment purchases with total project cost <u>></u> \$600,000
  - SCPHCA requesting an exemption for FQHCs or a renegotiation of the threshold.
