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External Update

- Planned changes to South Carolina Medicaid Managed Care Plans could affect 340B, potentially leading to a 23% reduction in revenue from 340B medications managed by an MCO.
- We have been informed that all grant objectives must be fully met; failure to do so may lead to decreased funding.
- South Carolina achieved the second-highest ranking nationwide for meeting clinical UDS measures.
- Participated in the recent SCPHCA Board meeting.
- Engaged in efforts related to access for the EHB, OPAIS, and Medicare programs.

MIECHV Award Overview

- Fiscal Year: October 1, 2024 - September 30, 2025
- Total award amount is \$1,401,043
- Funding supports HFA, PAT, and NFP programs
- HFA is allocated \$382,450
- PAT is allocated \$489,318
- NFP is allocated \$529,275
- The MIECHV award of \$1,401,043 was granted on July 29th. The individual budgets for each home visiting program (HFA, PAT, and NFP) were submitted last week and are currently awaiting approval.



MIECHV Budget and Contract Updates

- Budget for FY 2025-2026 is \$1,401,043
- Contracts for the next fiscal year pending
- Annual grant award process continues
- Award timing yet to be confirmed



HRSA ECD Grant Funding

- Fiscal Year: Sept 1, 2024 - Aug 30, 2025
- Third year receiving \$200,000 annually
- Supports HealthySteps program
- Funds Pediatric Care Coordinators at all sites



Greenwood Women Care Grant Details

- Awarded \$5,000 in October 2024
- Supports Nurse Family Partnership program
- Final report due December 2025



First Steps Lost funding

- Edgefield: \$12,500 effective 2/28/2025; enroll 4 first-time, low-income mothers before 28 weeks gestation.
- Saluda: \$20,000 effective 6/30/2025; enroll 5 such mothers (just short of target).
- Home visits must be at least 1 hour, which was challenging during virtual visits, but the requirement was eventually met with more in-person visits—100% in July 2025.
- Both counties face difficulties with referrals and enrollments, prompting increased outreach efforts.
