

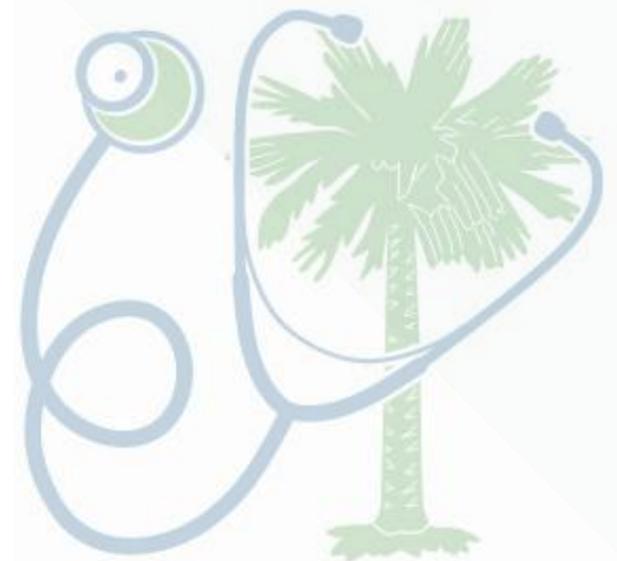

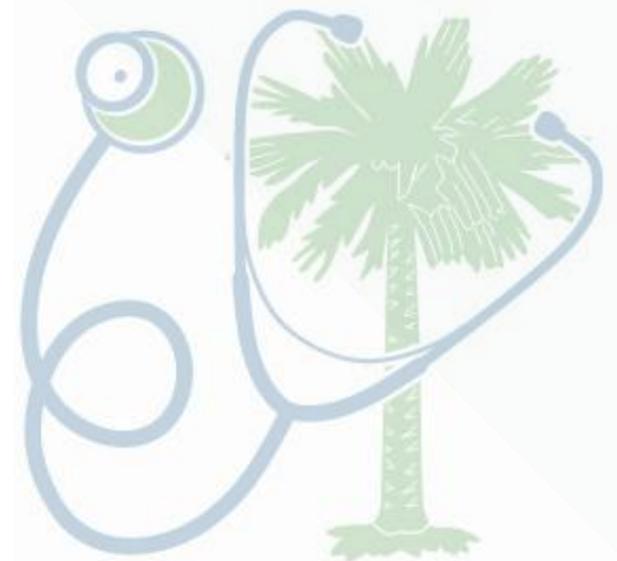
Clinical Inclusion in IT

Cybersecurity Landscape

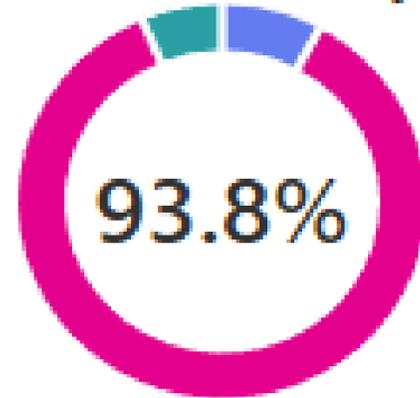
- **Ransomware remains the dominant threat**, driving major EHR outages, operational disruption, and large-scale data exposure across the sector.
- **Hacking/IT incidents continue to rise**, with 364 breaches affecting over 33 million people reported to HHS in the first 9 months of 2025.
- **AI-enhanced phishing and social engineering** are rapidly increasing credential theft, making email compromise a leading entry point for attackers.
- **Third-party/vendor breaches** are accelerating, causing cascading impacts across the healthcare sector.

Threats found

Total threats since deployment: 58

- 2 (22%) Mitigated threats
- No Not Mitigated threats
- 7 (78%) Marked as Benign threats

Mitigated: The Quarantine mitigation action completed successfully. The same status shows if Remediate or Rollback also completed.

Not Mitigated: No mitigation actions were completed, or the threat was killed but no other action was done.

Marked as Benign: Your security team marked this threat as benign (the Analyst Verdict is False Positive).



Outside Resources

We recently joined the **South Carolina Critical Infrastructure Cybersecurity Program (SCCIC)**.

Key aspects of the program include **free** access to:

1. **Risk Assessments:** Conducting thorough cybersecurity risk assessments for critical infrastructure sectors to identify vulnerabilities.
2. **Training and Awareness:** Providing cybersecurity training for infrastructure operators and public sector workers to improve awareness and readiness.
3. **Information Sharing:** Facilitating real-time information sharing about cyber threats and vulnerabilities between government and private sector entities.
4. **Incident Response:** Developing and coordinating response protocols for handling cybersecurity incidents that affect critical infrastructure, ensuring a quick and efficient recovery.
5. **Collaboration with Federal Agencies:** The program often collaborates with national entities like the Department of Homeland Security's Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) to align state efforts with federal cybersecurity initiatives.



IT Projects

- **Windows 11 Migration Completed**
Successfully upgraded **730+ computers** ahead of Microsoft's deadline; required significant device replacement, resulting in a higher-than-usual IT spend this year.
- **Welcome Tablets Pilot Deployment**
Launched at **Lakelands Pediatrics** to streamline patient questionnaires; providing **major time savings**, improved data accuracy, and planned expansion to additional sites with future self-check-in capabilities.
- **Barcode Medication & Immunization Inventory Tracking**
Implementing barcode scanning within Epic to **increase documentation accuracy**, improve pharmacy inventory control, and reduce clinical risk from medication errors.
- **Local Hyperspace Migration (Replacing Citrix/Slingshot)**
Transitioning to Local Hyperspace to avoid **300% Citrix cost increase** and to significantly improve performance—saving users **~1 minute per Epic launch** and preventing session disconnects.
- **MyChart Direct Scheduling**
Enabled patient self-service appointment scheduling in MyChart; **pilot underway at Hometown**, with broader rollout planned.
